- 8- How is TD part of sustainable Peace processes in nurturing transversal responses to the problems and priority rights of the human family with other living beings without going through violence?
- 9- How does TD feed new paradigms of sensitive, transparent, shared intelligences and knowledge that go beyond all segmentations, divisions and predator vs. predator logics?
- 10-Do we have the strategies and the theoretical, methodological and practical devices to strengthen transdisciplinary projects of social justice, peace and human solidarity?
- 11- What role should researchers, academics and teachers at multiple educational levels play in articulating transdisciplinarity in their daily work and coexistence scenarios?
